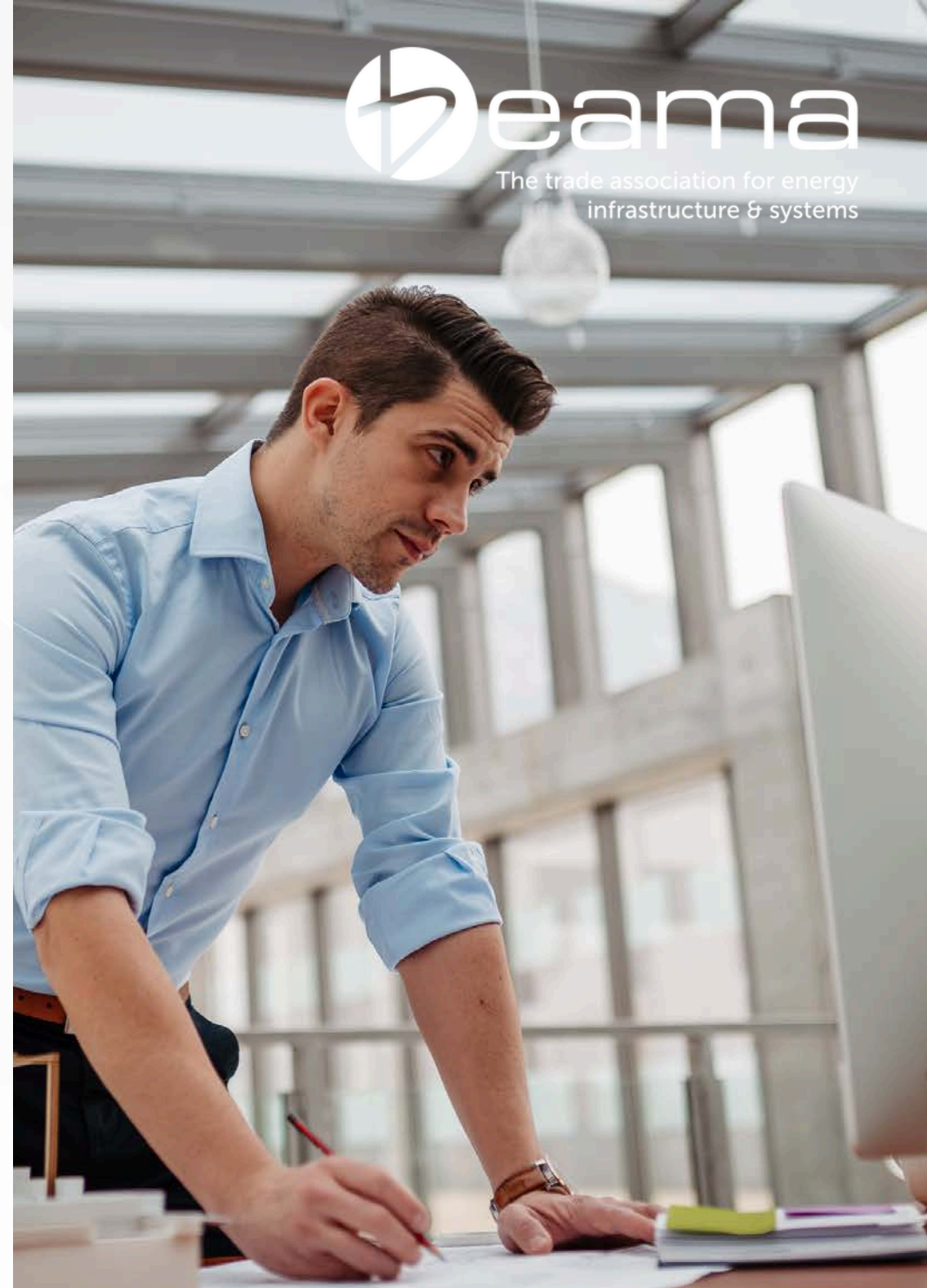

Who is in Scope?

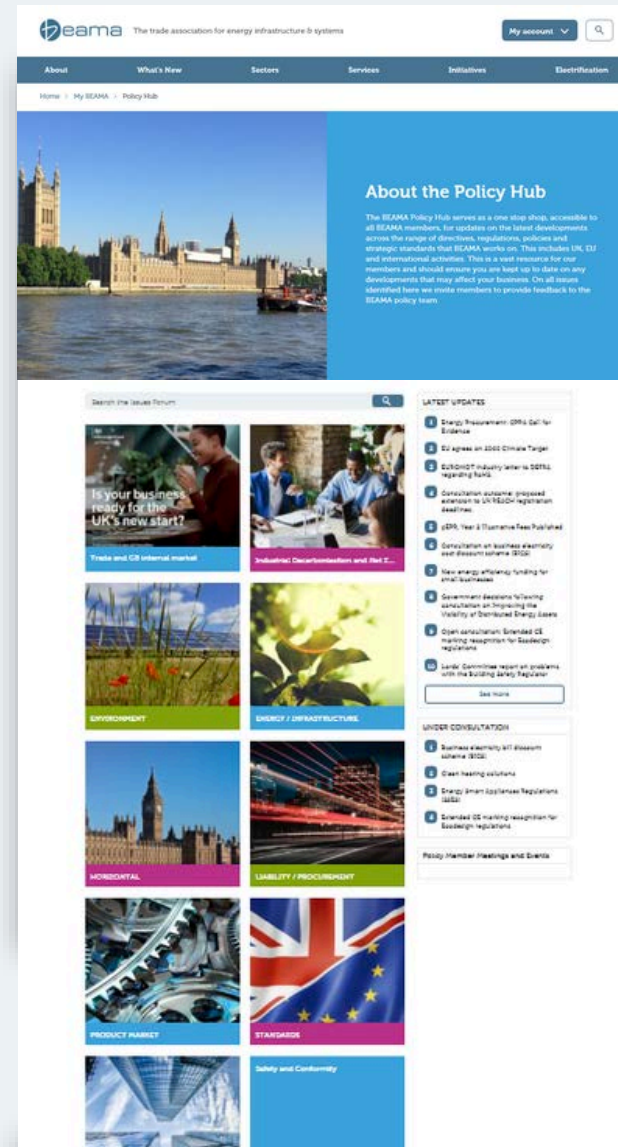
That's why we place a high value on keeping all members up to date with the latest policy, regulatory and legislative developments.
